

Pre-Operative Instructions:

Drop off time at the clinic located at 29 Mortimer Drive Evington, Va is 7:30 Monday through Thursday. Cranky or special needs animals will be taken in as schedule allows—call us so that we can alleviate as much stress to you and your pet as possible.

Pick up time at the clinic will generally be the same day of surgery 1:30 for dogs and 4:00 for cats.

If the drop off or pick-up time is not convenient, please let us know and we will be more than happy to work with you. Our number is 434-821-4922

It is IMPERATIVE that you let us know of ANY and ALL medical conditions your pet has or is experiencing, so that we can make informed decisions regarding your pet's best care

For the SAFETY of all of our clients and pets, please LEAVE your pet in your vehicle until you have checked in and filled out your paperwork. ALL dogs MUST be on a leash or in a separate carrier (for discharge) and ALL cats must be in a separate veterinarian approved carrier or cage for feral cats (for discharge). Cardboard carriers may be purchased for \$5.00 and can be purchased at any time.

Animals should **NOT** have anything to eat after midnight prior to surgery, ingestion of food prior to surgery can be life threatening. Water is fine up to 5:00am

Rabies vaccines are REQUIRED by Virginia state law. We must have paper proof of current rabies vaccine from your full service vet at time of surgery, which can be emailed to spayneuter@lynchburghumane.org or brought with you. Rabies tags are not acceptable forms of proof.
